

TRANSFER FACT SHEET

General Criteria for Admission

- A minimum of **24** transferable credits, with a cumulative GPA of **2.50** is required
- Must be in good standing and eligible to return to institutions attended previously
- Must meet basic college-preparatory unit requirements (typically completed in high school)
- Must demonstrate an ability to succeed in the College of Business (generally evaluated by math course selection and academic performance)



Business Majors

Offers undergraduate majors in:

- Accounting
- Entrepreneurial Management
- Finance
- General Business
- Global Business
- Marketing
- Supply Chain Management

The business programs are accredited by AACSB International - The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business.

College-Specific Criteria

For direct admission to the any major in the College of Business Administration, the following courses must be completed (or currently enrolled) with an overall grade point average of 2.7 or better:

- Micro and Macro Economics
- Management and Financial Accounting
- Business Statistics
- Calculus (or QBA 1 & 2)

Note: The College of Business will accept a limited number of students each semester who are enrolled in University College or are transferring from another institution with no more than 75 credits earned at the time of application (including currently enrolled courses).



International Business Program

The Program leads the student simultaneously to **two degrees**: a B.S. in business and a B.A. in German, French, Spanish or a minor in Chinese and Asian Studies.



Students study a foreign language and culture each semester along with a business curriculum. In the fourth year of the five-year program the student will study abroad

The Application Process

- Click Apply Now on the URI Admission website <http://www.uri.edu/admission>.
- On the Common Application website log-in and register as a user by filling in all required fields.
- Select the University of Rhode Island.
- Follow the menu-driven pages through each of the sections. Click on "Save" and "Next," each time you advance to the next page.
- Submit the application and URI supplement (after you have certified the accuracy and honesty of the entire form on the certification page) by clicking on "Submit."
- Click on "Payment" and fill in your credit card information to pay online.

Credit Transferability

Generally, courses completed at other regionally accredited post-secondary institutions with a grade of C or better will be accepted, provided they are similar in quality, content and character to courses offered at URI.

Credit transferred from other schools is limited by the following restrictions:

- No more than half of the credits URI requires for graduation can be transferred from two-year institutions
- Students must earn at URI at least one-half of the credits required for a major, and at least one-fourth of the credits required for graduation
- Only grades earned for course work at URI are included in the calculation of a student's grade point average.
- An official transfer credit evaluation will be available online within 21 days of admission.



Required Materials for Transfer Applicants

- High school transcript
- Official college transcript from each college/university attended
- Essay
- A letter of recommendation
- \$65 application fee
